



## Candoo How to Use Alexa with Amazon Echo Show.

**To print this guide, go to "File" and click "Print".**

### Step 1

Tap on the Alexa App to start the setup process. The App is available in both the Apple App Store and the Google Play Store.

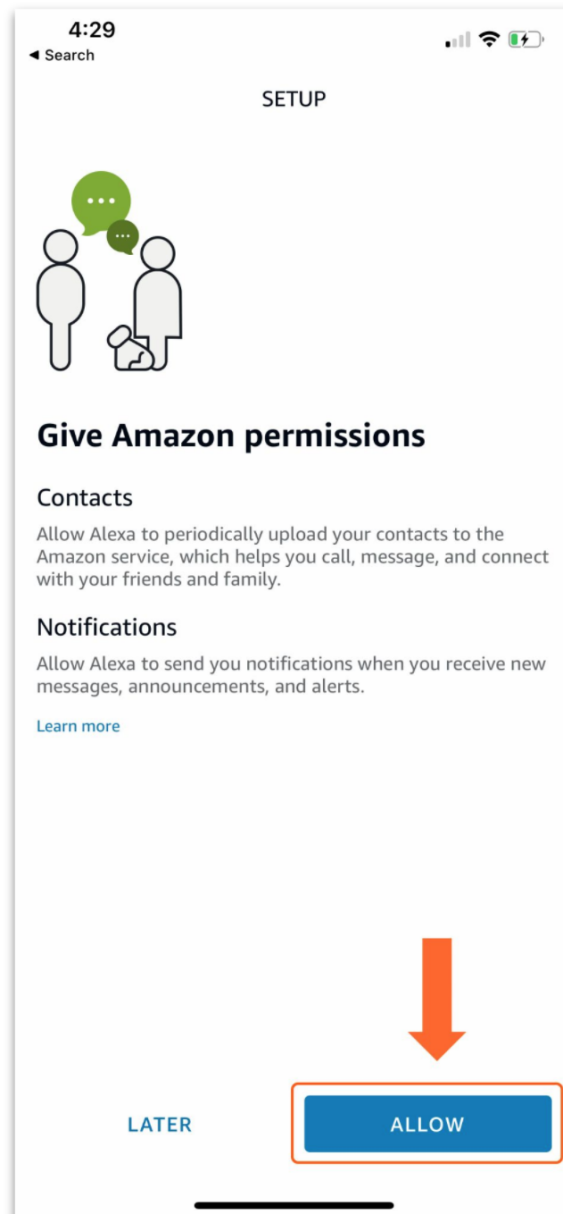
## Step 2

Enter your Amazon Username and Password and tap Sign-In. If you are new to Amazon tap "Create a New Amazon Account."

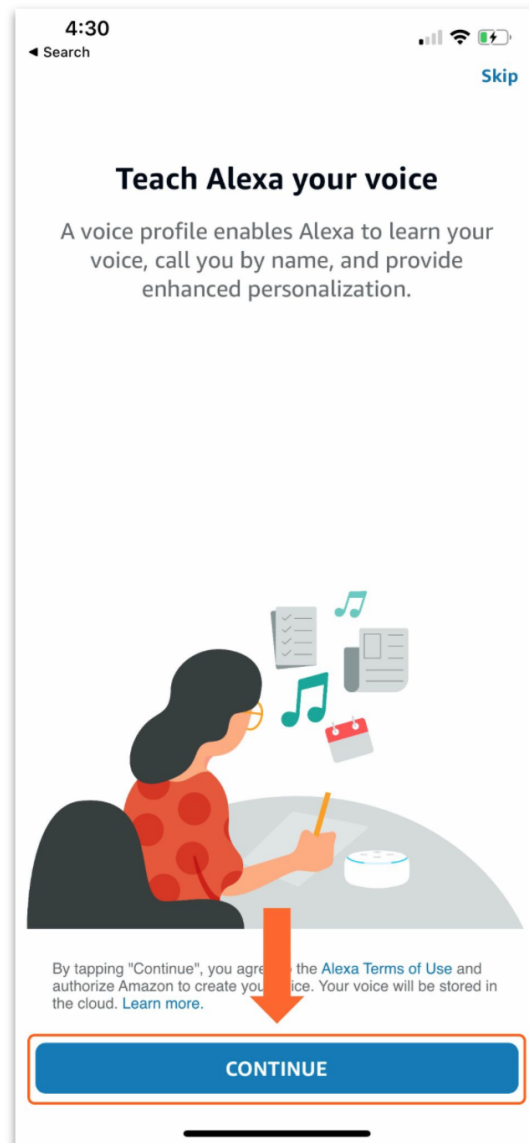
## Step 3

Tap "Allow" to give Amazon permission to access your Contacts and send Notifications. You can also choose to do this later if you wish.



## Step 4

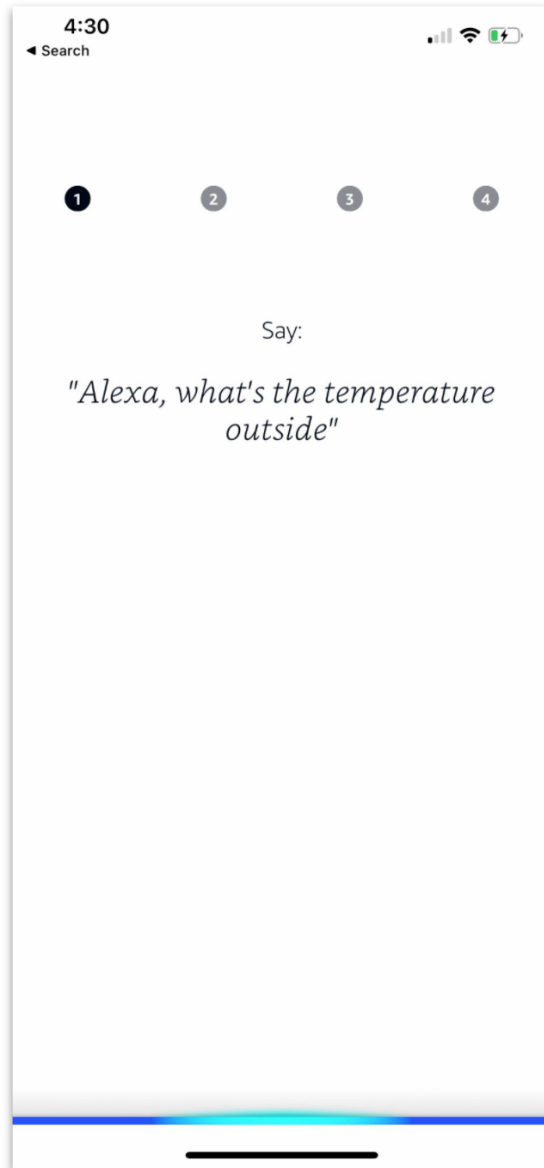
Next you will need to teach Alexa your voice. Tap "Continue" to get started.





## Step 5

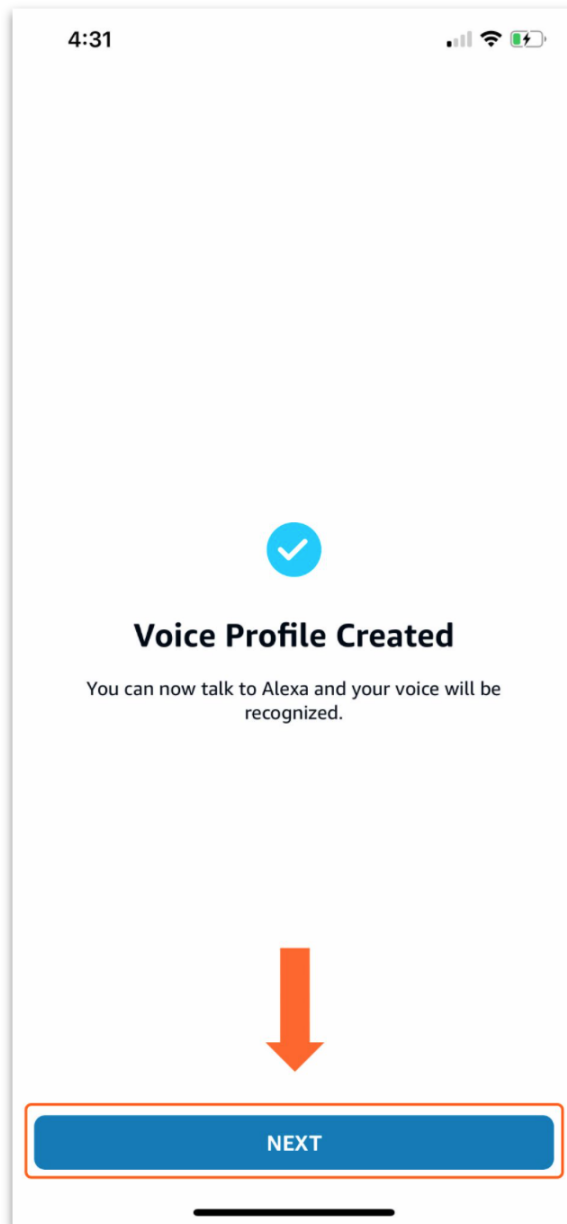
You will be asked to speak a series of phrases. This will help Alexa learn your voice.





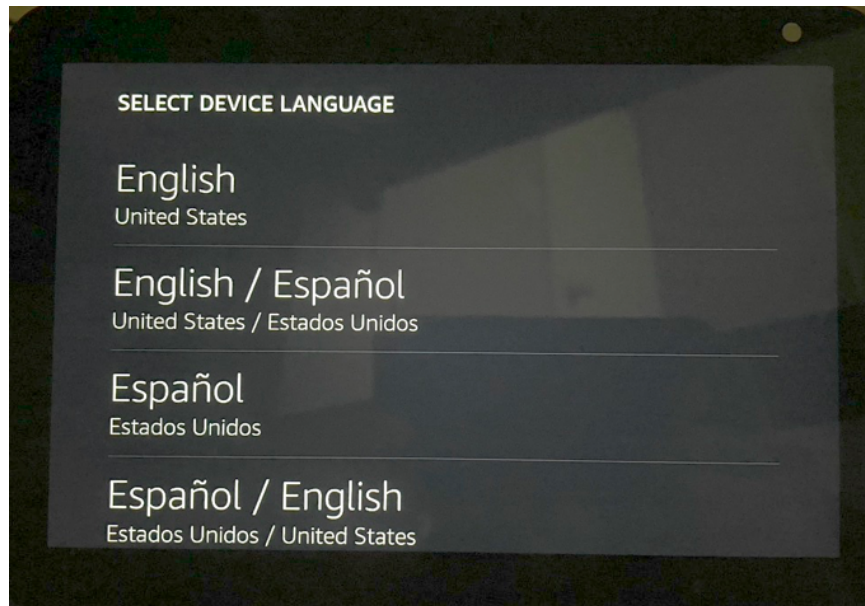
## Step 6

When completed, tap "Next" to continue..



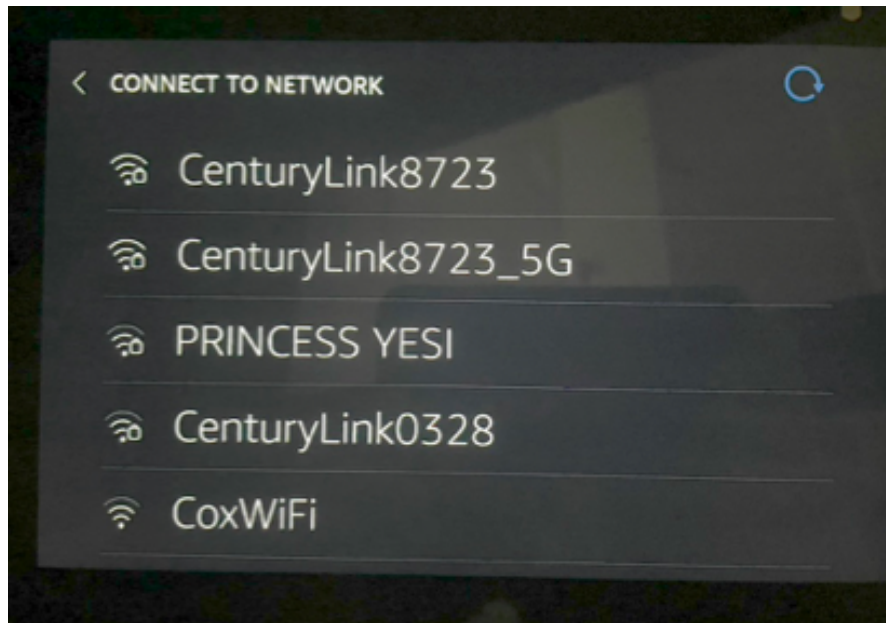
## Step 7

Now that the Alexa app is ready to go, plug in the Echo Show to complete the setup. Once it starts up, you will be prompted to select the language.

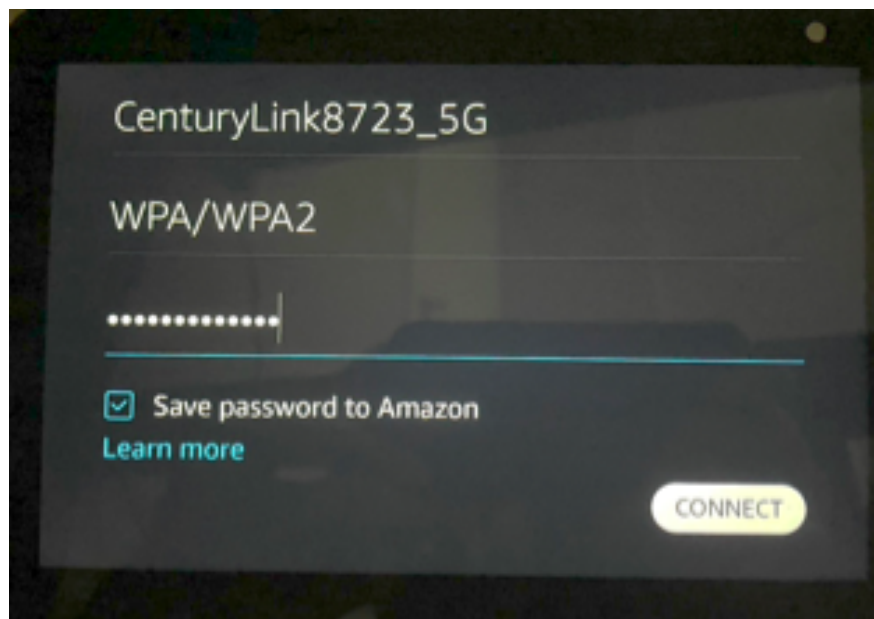
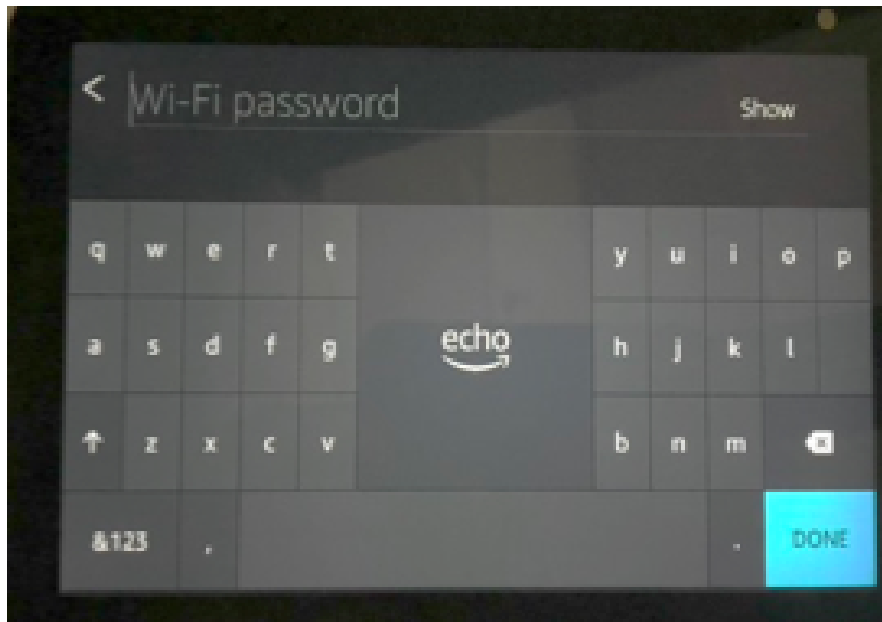


## Step 8

Select your WiFi network. This will allow the Echo Show to connect to the internet.

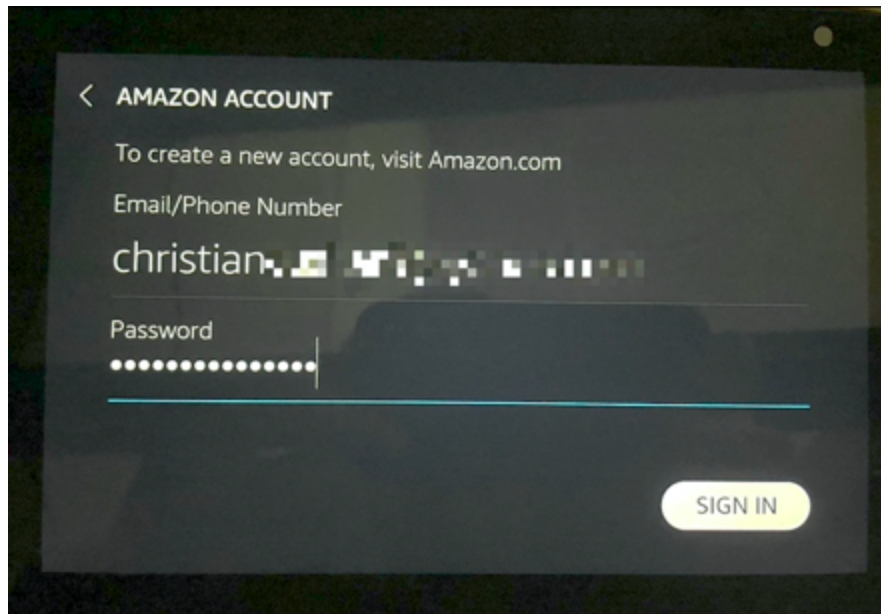


If your WiFi network is password protected, enter it in the following screen.

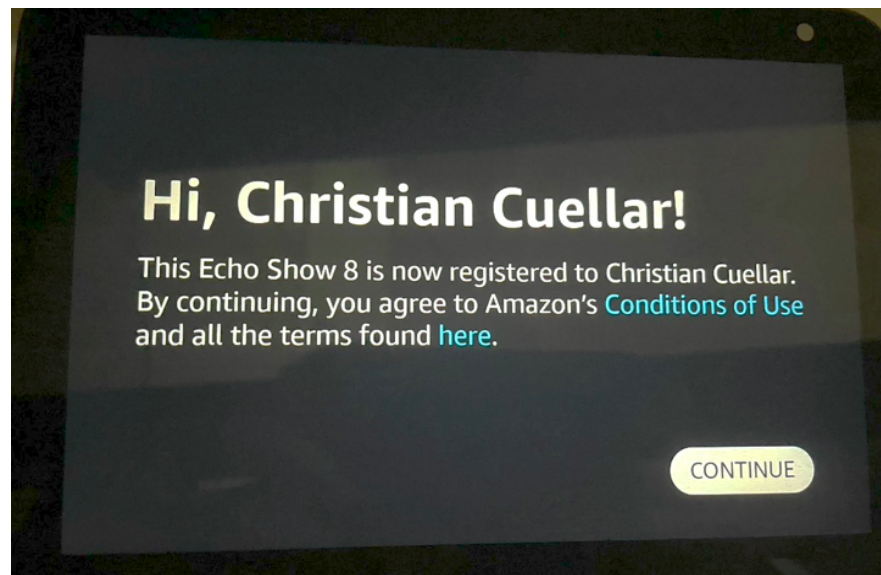


## Step 9

Next, you will be asked to enter your Amazon account login info. Make sure that it is for the same account that you used earlier for the Alexa app (Steps 1 thru 6).



You will receive a confirmation message notifying you that the device is now registered to your account.



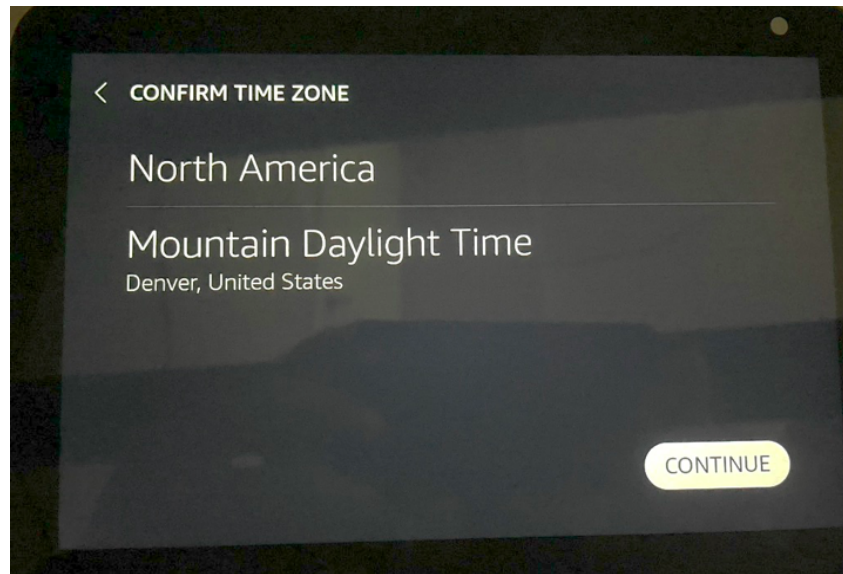

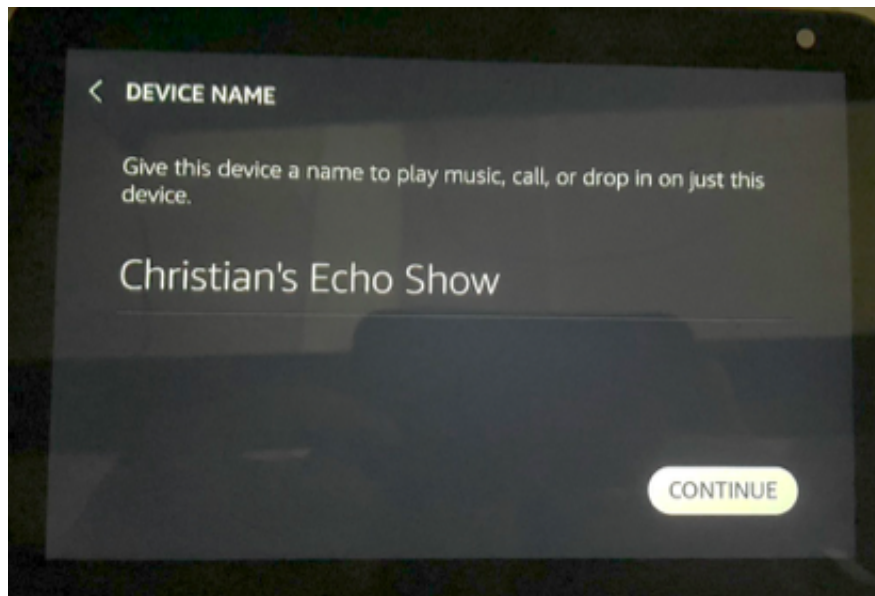
## Step 10

Next you will confirm your Time Zone, add your address, and choose the room that the Echo Show will be located in.



## Step 11

Next you will need to choose a name for the device. If you have multiple Echo devices in your home, creating a different name will help you keep them organized.



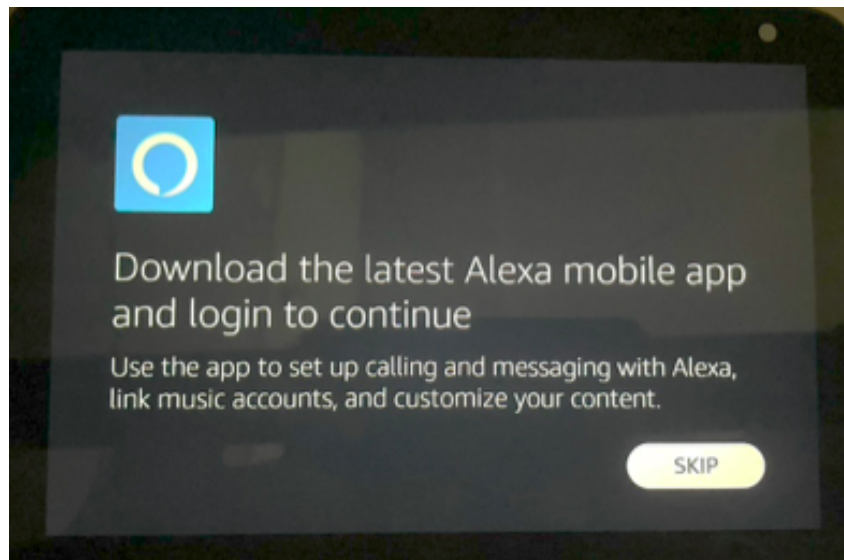
## Step 12

Next choose the type of background you want displayed on your Echo Show. You select photos that you have saved or swipe down on the screen for additional themes.



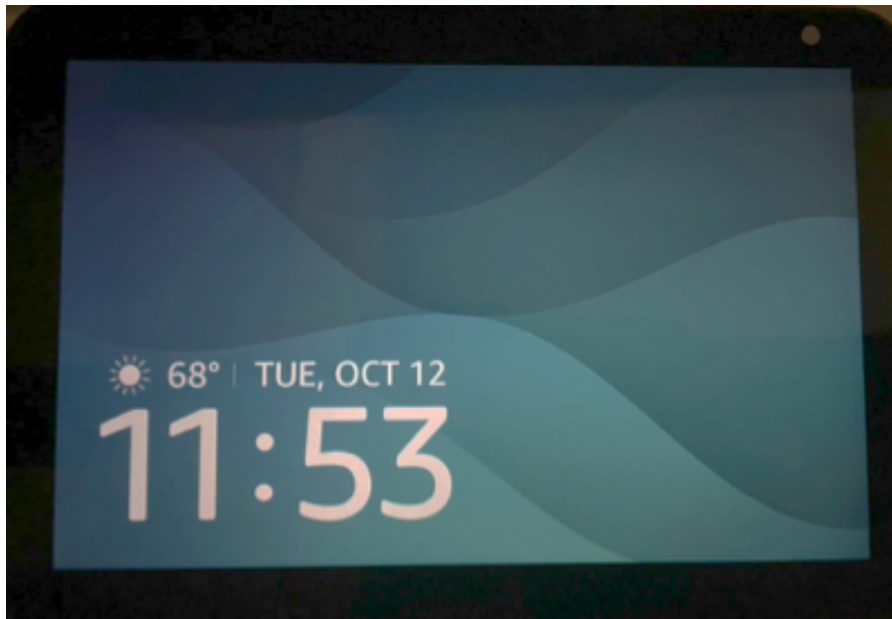
## Step 13

Next you will receive a message making sure that you have downloaded and logged into the Alexa app on your mobile device. Since we already did this (Steps 1 thru 6) we can tap Skip.



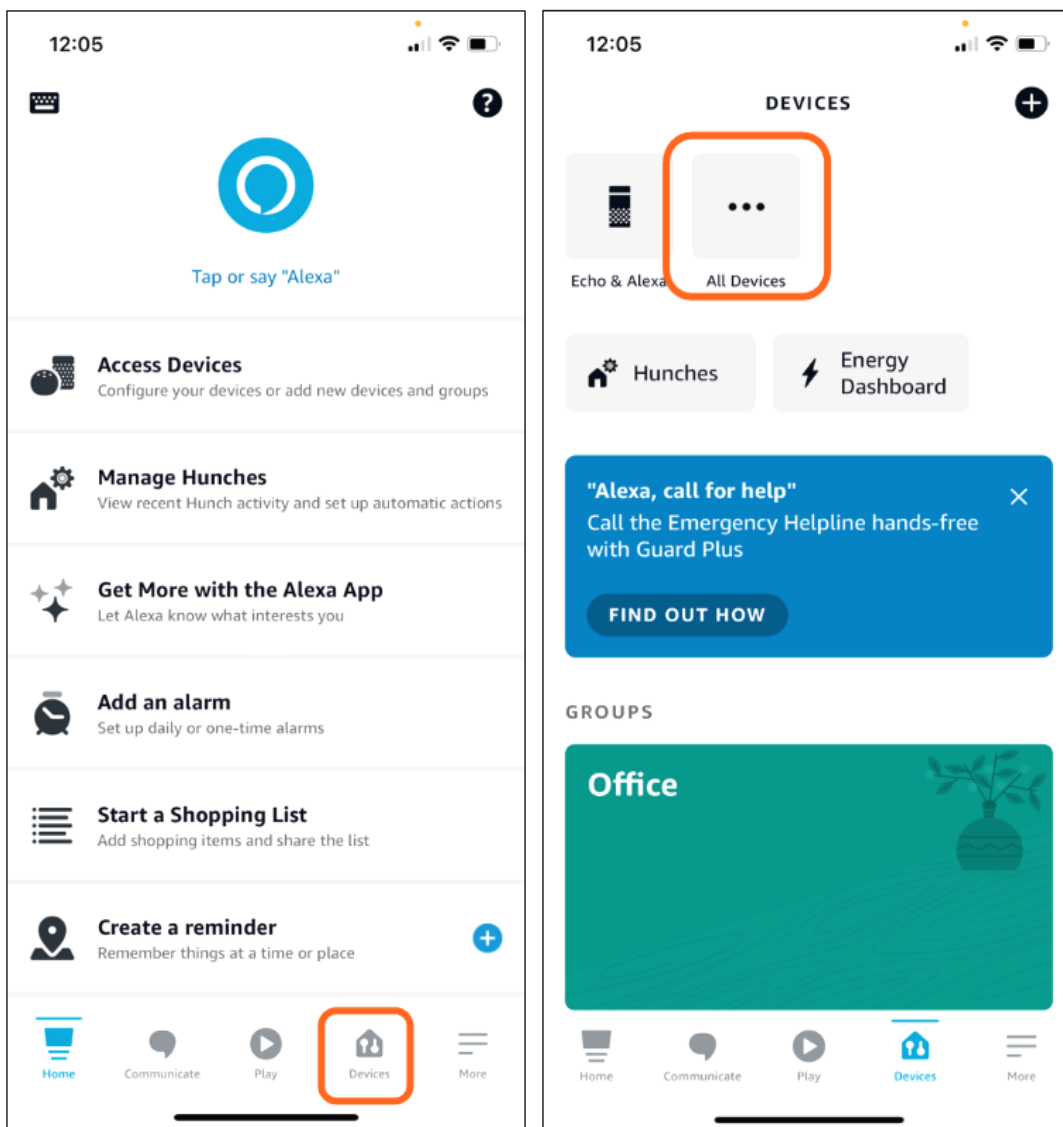
## Step 14

The Echo Show setup is now complete! Here is how the Home screen on the Echo Show may look like.



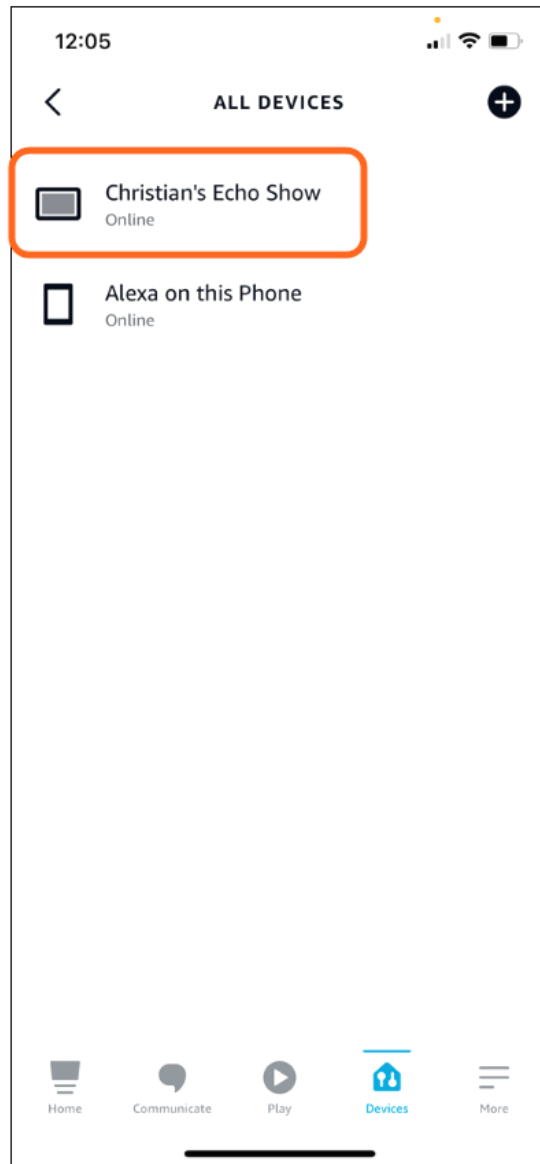
## Step 15

To confirm that the Echo Show is connected to the Alexa app on your mobile device, open the Alexa app and tap on the Devices menu button at the bottom. Tap on "All Devices" on the next screen.



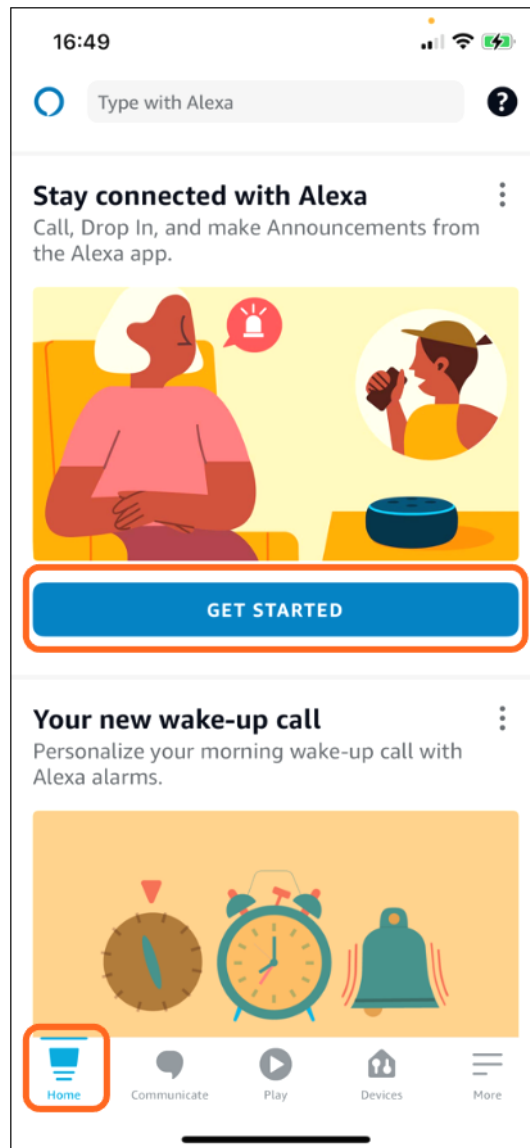


On the 'All Devices' screen, you will find the Echo Show listed under the name you chose for it during the setup process for it.



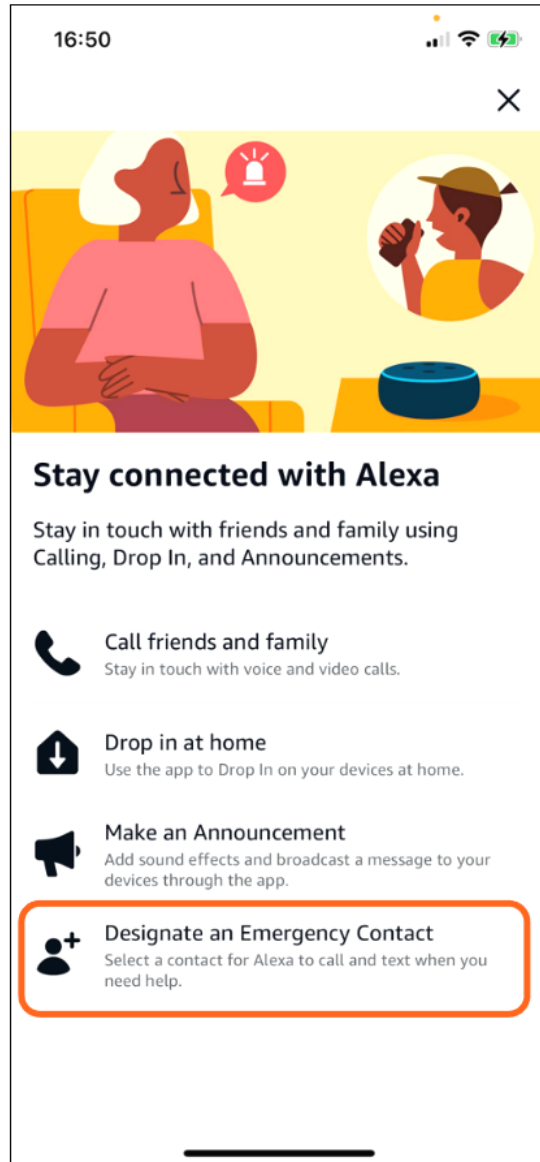
## Step 16

To set up an Emergency Contact, Tap on the “Home” button at the bottom of the screen. Scroll down until you find a section titled “Stay connected with Alexa”. Tap on “Get Started”.





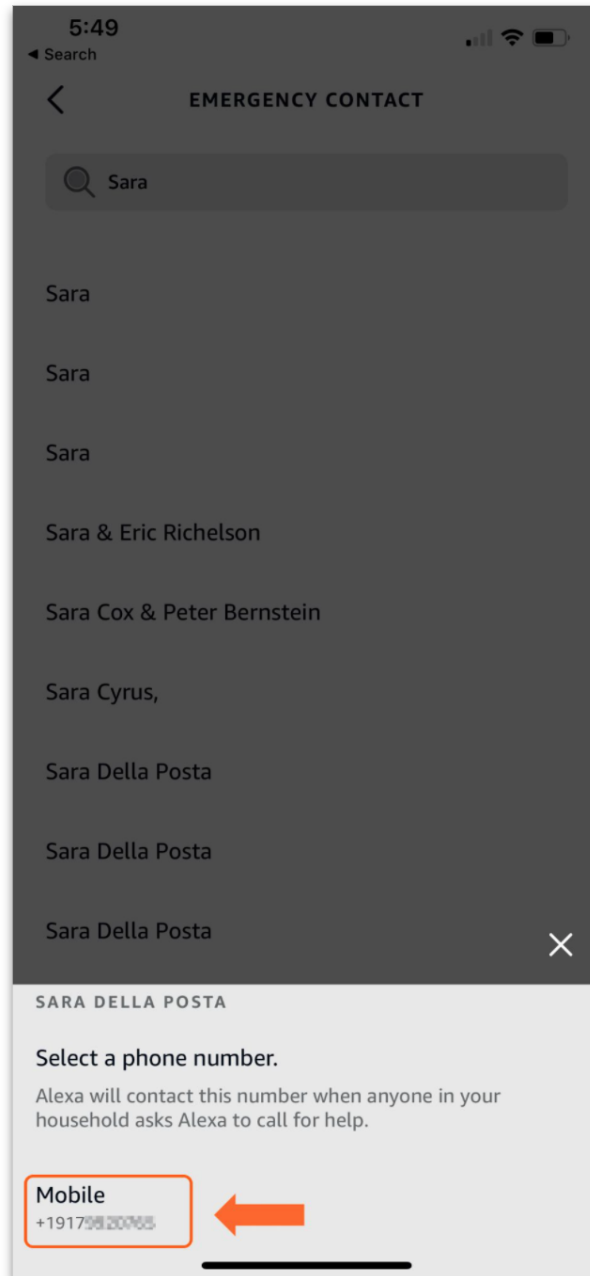
On the next screen, tap on “Designate an Emergency Contact” to proceed.





## Step 16

Tap the name of the contact you wish to use and then tap on the number to assign as the Emergency Contact. In this case it is a Mobile Number.



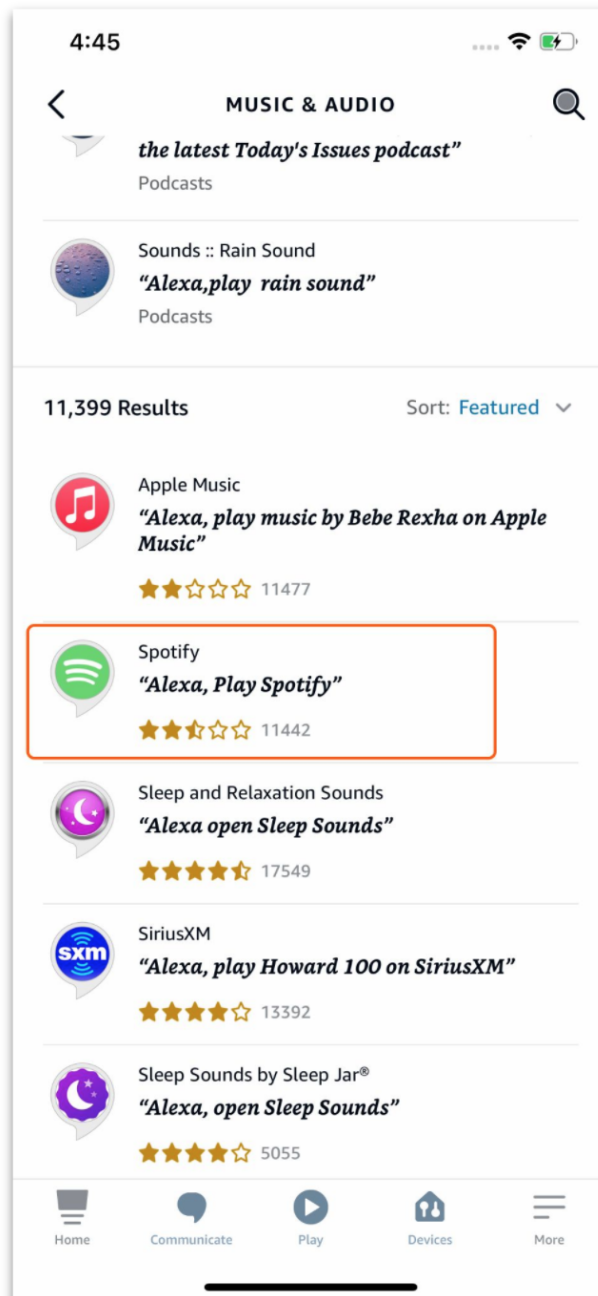
## Step 17

Now if you say, "Alexa, Call for Help", your emergency contact will get both a text message and a phone call so that you can speak to them.



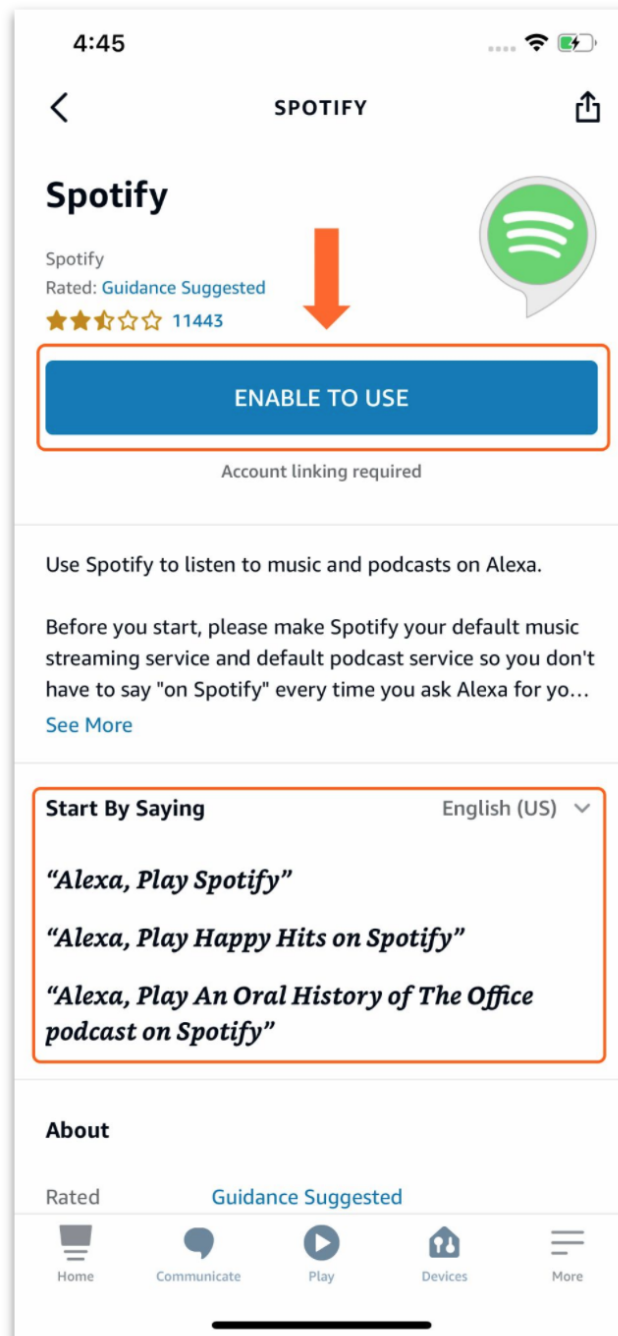
## Step 18

To add a Skill to Alexa, search for the skill you want and tap on it to start. In this case we will be adding "Spotify".



## Step 19

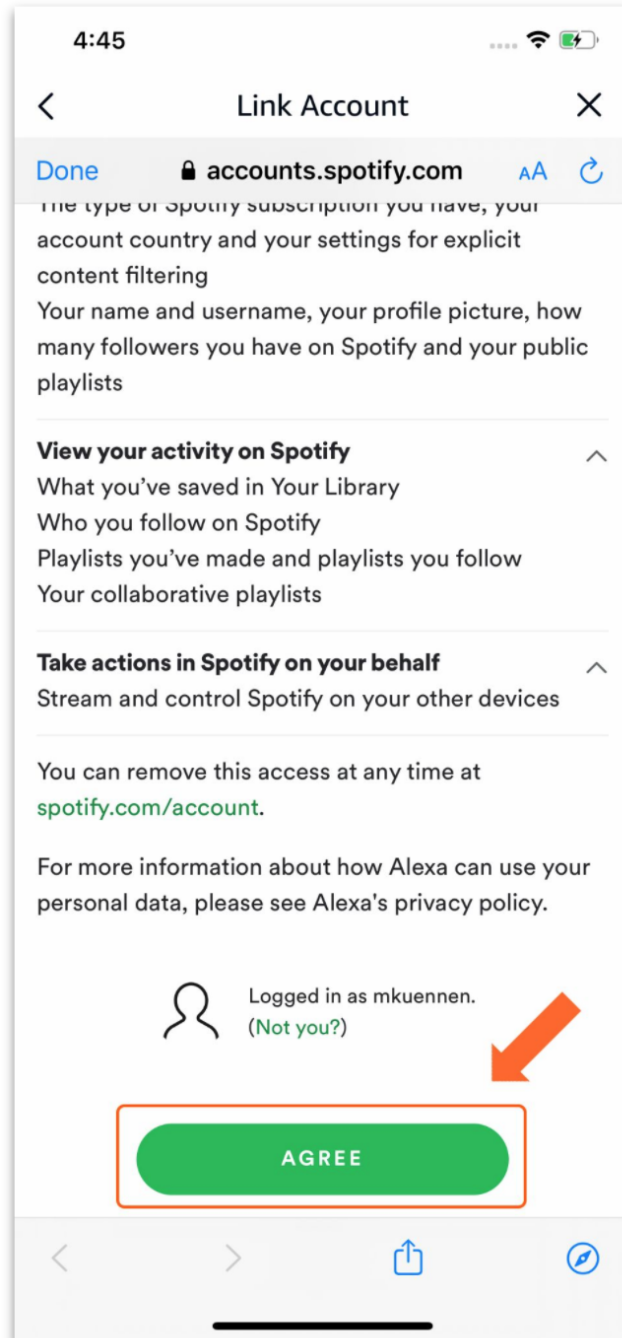
Tap "Enable To Use" to continue to link Spotify.





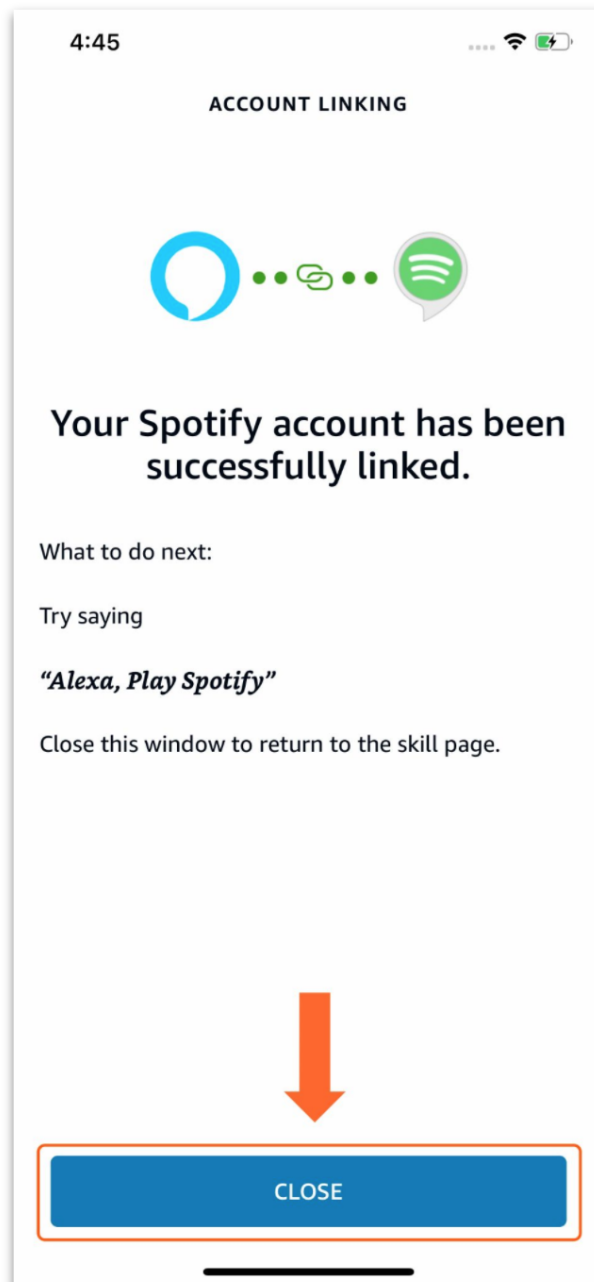
## Step 20

Tap "Agree" to link your Spotify Account to Alexa.



## Step 21

Tap "Close" to finish the process. You can now say "Alexa, Play Spotify" to play music on your Echo.
